Sun Printing on Fruit.

B. J. Martin, through the Portland Oregonian, has the following to say in regard to making Oregon fruit famous, and as a boost for Oregon: The following will be found a very pretty way to advertise their fruit, as well as home town at the same time, by sun printing on fruit.

Monograms, initial letters or other designs can be printed on such fruit as apples, pears or peaches, by the action of the sun, with very pretty effect of either a light or dark color. To do this, draw the monogram letter or design on a piece of writing paper and paste it with mucilage or glue upon the side of the fruit exposed to the sun, just before the fruit begins to color.

When the fruit is ripe and the paper is removed, the design will appear in a lighter or different color from the rest of the fruit. For instance, if the experiment is tried on a yellow flesh peach with a red cheek, the design will appear in gold surrounded with red.

If the opposite effect is intended, take a small oval or circular piece of paper and cut out the letter or design in it, and paste on the fruit, which, when ripe, will have the design in high color or yellow on a light green ground of the shape of the piece of paper. This design again will be surrounded by the brighter color of the fruit.

Fruit decorated in this way, when shipped to the East or foreign countries, would advertise Oregon more than any other way that I know of. Try it, Oregon farmers, and boost your state. If you cannot spare the time yourself to do it, turn the job over to your sons and daughters, and get them interested in it, as they would like to see the name of the old farm or town on fruit that was being shipped out of the state. PROPOSALS WANTED.

For Crushing and Hauling Rock.

Sealed bids will be received by the County Court of Washington County, Oregon, until 2:00 P. M. of the 14th day of March, 1908, and then opened for the crushing of 5500 cubic yards of rock, 2000 yards at the Thatcher quarry four miles north of Forest Grove, 2000 yards at the Spring Hill quarry four miles south of Forest Grove and 1500 yards at the Cedar Mill quarry three miles north of Beaverton on the Cornell road.

The County will furnish the crusher now at the Thatcher quarry. The contractor will be required to move and set up the machinery at the different quarries.

Bidders will be required to name a price per Cubic yard delivered in the bins, the two finer grades to comprise at least 45 per cent of the product, also a price for the excess needed over the 45 per cent of the two finer grades.

Bids will also be received at the same time for the hauling of said rock, bids to state the price per cubic yard, per mile.

Bids may be made on the crushing alone or on the crushing and hauling together or on any part of the hauling.

The court reserves the right to increase the above amounts of rock to be crushed 50 per cent at each of the quarries, also the right to reject any or all bids.

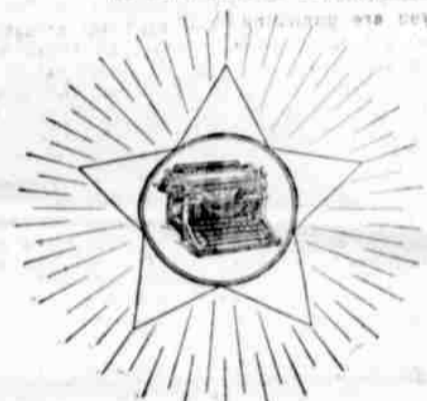
