San Francisco, Nov. 20.—California alone raised a bean crop this season sufficient to supply all the armed forces of the nation for a year or more. The nation raised a bean crop approximately 8,000,000 bushels in excess of the biggest previous crop, while the bean output of the Orient is so enormous that its marketing and transportation problems are engaging the attention of the governments and merchants all over the world.

Y., August 31, were selected during the first day of her trial here.

A number of the 60 or more concerns that fish for salmon in Bristol Bay, and the waters off central and southeastern Alaska are unloading their last ships in various parts along the coast their efforts in catching both the red and the pink salmon having met with signal success.

RUSSIAN SUGAR SUPPLY SEIZED IN NEW YORK

New York, Nov. 21.—Ten thousand tons of sugar, purchased for the imperial Russian government before the revolution and stored here, has been seized by federal authorities.

EIGHTY THOUSAND ARE HANGED IN AUSTRIA

London, Nov. 21.—Eighty thousand persons have been hanged in Austria-Hungary since the beginning of the war, for political or racial opposition to the government, pacifist activities and separatist propaganda, according to estimates here.
