COMMERCIAL FERTILIZERS USED ON GARDEN SOILS

Oregon Agricultural College, Corvallis, Mar. 12. Constantly increasing scarcity of stable manure available for vegetable gardens is becoming very apparently acute at this time of year, when many gardeners, especially those in small towns, are beginning to figure on spring soil preparation, says A. G. Bouquet,

professor of vegetable gardening. In view of the inability to get manure, he offers the following suggestions on the use of commercial fertilizers on vegetable land:

A commercial fertilizer containing 3 per cent nitrogen, 7 or 8 per cent phosphoric acid and 2 to 3 per cent potash, may profitably be broadcast over the garden in the spring at the rate of 6 to 8 pounds to the square rod. This should lightly be harrowed into the soil.

Nitrate of soda is particularly useful for such plants as lettuce, cabbage, cauliflower, onions and celery, grown for their leafy parts. The normal application is at the rate of about 1 pound to the square rod. Sometimes it is more economical to apply to the plants in the row, one-half to one ounce for each plant. None should be allowed to stand on the leaves, as it will burn them.

Hardwood ashes, 40 to 50 pounds to the square rod, may be harrowed in in the spring. If too much is used it may make the soil alkali and

almost worthless. Lime and some available potash are added to the soil in the ashes.

Poultry manure is valuable for certain leafy vegetables, but is highly concentrated and will readily burn. It should be mixed with 3 or 4 times its bulk of soil in the form of compost, or spread very thinly over the ground and harrowed in.

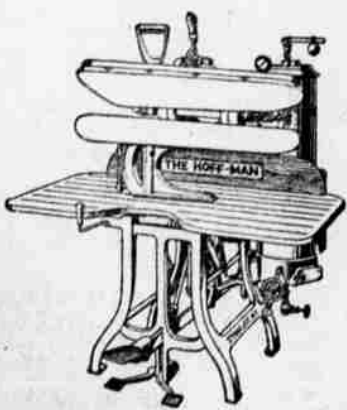
