GRANTS PASS DAILY COURIER Yellow Fever Mastered.

Reports from Ecuador indicate that Doctor Noguchi, the famous Japanese scientist, who is at present in that country, has isolated the bacillus which causes yellow fever, and has prepared an anti-serum conferring immunity on those exposed to the disease. The discovery is being tried out on Ecuadoran troops in the fevery interior. The conquest of yellow fever is one


