SOVIET ORGANIZATION STRONG SAYS MARTENS

Washington, Jan. 26.—That Russian soviet organizations have become "strong enough to fight the world," Ludwig C. A. K. Martens, soviet agent to the United States, told the senate investigating committee today. Because of this he said the soviets have ceased to urge international revolution to support them. He stated that the Russian soviets have "between four hundred and fifty and five hundred million dollars" in a public treasury which it is now desired to spend in foreign countries for the purchasing of necessities. He also said that there was now no gold in the hands of banks and private individuals in Russia.
