Never before has there been a project advanced for this district that promised so much for the community. The people are financing the proposition themselves. They are doing their own directing, and success is success for the community that will be served by the canals and ditches.

It will be a different community when the waters are brought to the acres than it has been previously. There is no questioning the value of irrigation in Josephine county. It is absolutely necessary to give full production from the lands and values must of course be based upon actual and not potential production.

One of the most favorable aspects of the situation is the personal interest which the bond purchaser is taking in the building of the system. He entered into the field without prejudices and his investigations proved the worth of the district that would stand back of the bonds into which he was putting his money.

The most desirable solution of the

building of a highway to the caves would be the construction of the complete highway connecting both the Williams and the Sucker creek valleys. That this will be the final result when work is once started upon the road from either end is the hope of practically every person who is familiar with the question, and when the proper time comes, every effort should be put forth to build the through road. This would not only make the caves approachable from either direction, but would open up a great body of timber and

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a rich mining district. It would also make communication between the citizens of the two great valleys possible without miles of travel.

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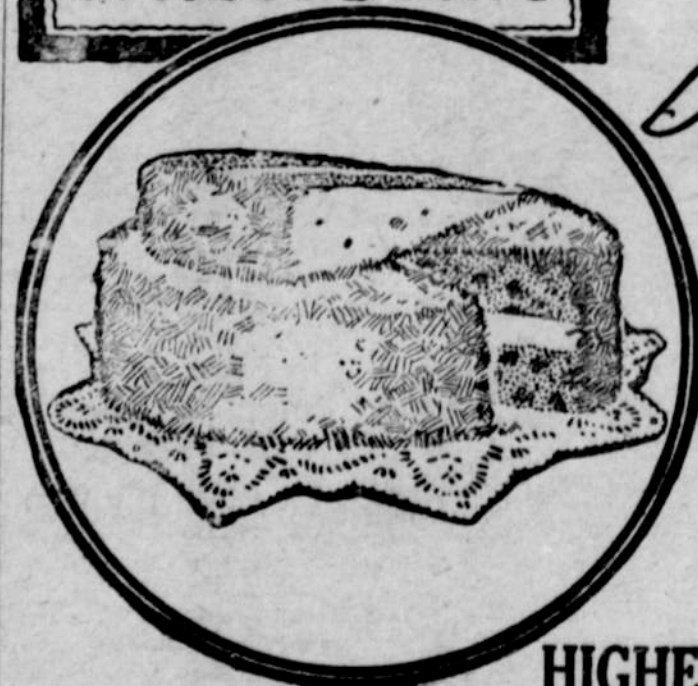
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
