YANKEE FAMILIES ARE NOT TO GO TO COBLENZ

American Headquarters, Coblenz, Germany, Feb. 24.—No more American officers are to be permitted to bring their wives from America to the Rhine, until living conditions improve in Coblenz. It was announced recently in a war department cable from Washington. Coblenz is one of the most crowded cities of Europe, being headquarters of the inter-allied Rhineland high commission in addition to the seat of command of the 15,000 United States troops stationed in the bridgehead area.

It is estimated that there are approximately 200 American officers with their wives in Coblenz, many officers having also brought over their children and servants. In numerous cases an American family and a German family are quartered in the same house or apartment, using the same kitchen. There is scarcely a German family in Coblenz which has not one or more allied soldiers or members of the Rhineland commission billeted in their home.
