THE MONTESANO VERDICT

Confidence in the jury system, the right of trial by "one's peers," gets quite a shock when we see twelve men good and true bring in such a verdict as the one at Montesano the other day. We fail to see where intelligent men could find the ground upon which to support such a verdict. If the I. W. W. defendants were guilty at all under the law, they were guilty of first degree murder. If the attack upon the ex-service men in parade was not deliberate and

premeditated, no such affair ever was. If it was, the only possible verdict was one of first degree murder. The reasoning of the jury was not in accord with the instructions, of the judge nor was it based on any written law. The jury system is not a perfect system after all. Instead of representing justice, it is a travesty upon justice when it goes so far astray as it did at Montesano.
