Sponge Formation.

Sponges form a group of animals known as the Porifera or pore-bearers, the lowest in the scale of life except the single-celled Protizon. They vary exceedingly in form, but all attach themselves to rocks or mud in warm, tideless seas and draw in water and air through minute pores, this being expelled through other openings. A jelly-like mass, the living animal is squeezed out of the sponges when the latter are being cleaned and prepared for market. The sponge develops from an egg, which forms a ciliated larva that swims around and finally attaches itself to one place. Only a few kinds of sponges find their way to the market, as in many cases their skeletons consist not of spongy fiber, but of hard siliceous or calcareous spicules.
