"WHEN WE GET IRRIGATION—"

In all the battle that has waged around the high cost of living, two fundamentals have emerged as the basic remedy for the evil: We ourselves must build up production and cut down waste.

Today the steady flow of life-giving water into five canal systems removes many hundreds of acres in the Rogue river valley from the column of waste to that of increasing production. The people in the valley of the Rogue have made a definite step in reducing living costs and in building up a real home-land in Southern Oregon.

For several decades past the residents here have told their visitors, "Yes, with this climate and this beautiful country, we will have a veritable Paradise for home-makers WHEN WE GET IRRIGATION."

And the visitors have replied throughout those several decades: "Yes, with this climate and this beautiful country, you will attract us here for home-making WHEN YOU GET IRRIGATION."

And while the boosters have orated to the effect that water will be forthcoming "next year," the visitors have meditated to the effect that they will "see the water first."

Today, June of 1920, there is no

need for "next year," the visitors are invited to step to the ditch and see the water. It is there, hundreds of thousands of gallons of it, flowing over the expanses of valley bottom, diverted to the fields and sinking satisfyingly into the loam of garden or orchard, the "when" has been eliminated and "we get irrigation."

There are three sub-systems in the 1920 development, known as the Northeast unit, Northwest unit and South Side unit, each now actually delivering water to six or eight hundred acres in crop. These units are separate and distinct in their present operation, but have been so designed in the engineering scheme that on completion of the ultimate gravity project, each unit will be a part of and distributing area for the main gravity canal. The beauty of the development of the project in installments, however, lies in the fact that no man need say, "Wait till

next year." The water is today on the land. The ultimate project will be greater, broader and more comprehensive; it will mean gravity water instead of pumped water, but while that is all coming, the water is here, and the Rogue river valley invites the world to see it.

Five enormous centrifugal pumps are discharging the waters of the Rogue into the network of laterals and canals, each canal being in itself a small-sized river properly located for the advantage of the tiller of the soil.

In the changing affairs of men, there is today no failure of promoters no loss of heart or courage in the backing of unknown capitalists, which can rob the people of what they have, water running in the ditches, an irrigation system in actual operation, a means of increased production.

For many decades we have waited for it; in June of 1920 we have it.
