### First Negro Clergyman.

In 1780 on November 20, Samuel Haynes, a mulatto, was licensed to preach. He was the first negro clergyman in the United States. Haynes was born at West Hartford, Conn., in 1753. He served as a soldier in the revolution, and after the war became a servant in the house of the Rev. Daniel Ferrand, a Congregational minister at Granville, Conn. Doctor Ferrand taught Haynes Latin and Greek and helped him to study for the ministry. In 1785 he was formally ordained a Congregational minister at Litchfield, Conn., and shortly after was assigned to the parish of Torrington. He resigned after two years on account of the prejudice of his parishioners. He was called immediately to a church at Rutland, Vt., where he preached for 18 years.

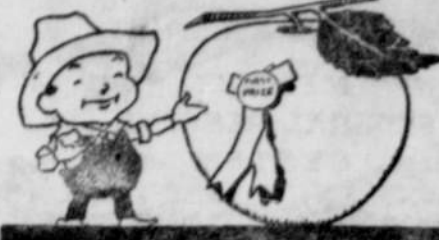
MACK trucks are built in two types. The models under 3 tons' capacity are known as AB; those over as AC. The motors are identical except as to size.

The AB power plant, including engine, clutch, transmission and instrument board may be removed as a unit. The AC engine may be slid out the front by removing the bumper.
