established." It merely renewed "within the limitation of international comity and usage" the previous expressions of the Democratic party of sympathy with Irish aspirations for self government.

Among other international subjects touched upon was the non-admission of Asiatic immigrants which was declared to be as a national policy "a true expression of the judgment of our people." Support was pledged in studies where the enforcement of that policy was of particular moment.
