Prophet's Gourd.

The "prophet's gourd" is a name given to the ricinus communis, or castor oil plant, referred to in Jonah 4:6-10, which afforded shade to the prophet before Nineveh, and which was supposed to have come up in a night and perished in a night. This plant was formerly a native of Asia, but is now naturalized in America, Africa and the south of Europe. It is allied to the cucumber, but in some species the fruit attains enormous sizes, specimens having been found to weigh as much as two and three hundred pounds. In India the plant is a tree, but in England it seldom attains a greater height than three or four feet. The seeds contain the oil so well known as castor oil.
