Married Here Yesterday—

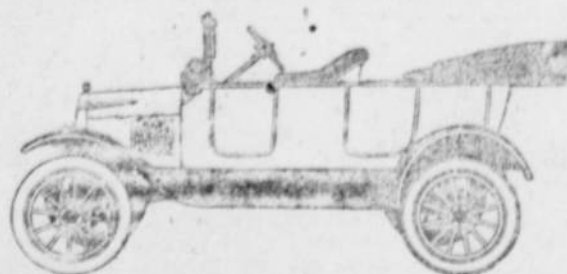
