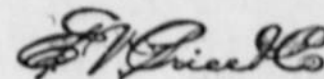

Lindquest Has "Voice of Gold," Says Famous  
Tenor of the Chicago Opera Company

Lindquest's rise in the concert world has been phenomenal. He is a truly distinguished American tenor possessing a voice of exquisite lyric quality, and that priceless asset, a broad musical intellect. With Mr. Lindquest is Leonora Allen, lyric soprano, and Robert MacDonald, accompanist. Miss Allen (Mrs. Lindquest) is a fitting companion artist for the noted young tenor. Like Mr. Lindquest she has appeared extensively in concert work and has been soloist with the country's leading symphony orchestras during the past few years. She made her debut in "Romeo et Juliet" at the Auditorium in 1910 and for two years was soloist at the Emanuel Baptist temple, Brooklyn, New York.

Robert MacDonald is one of the leading young pianists of Chicago and a masterly solo artist.
