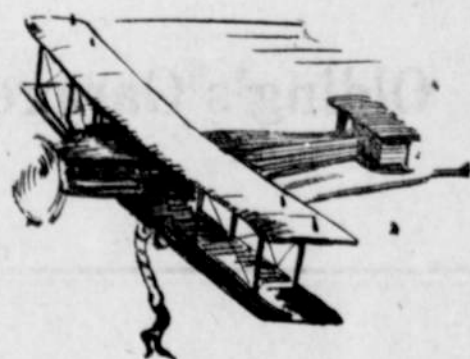
THE CITY EDITOR

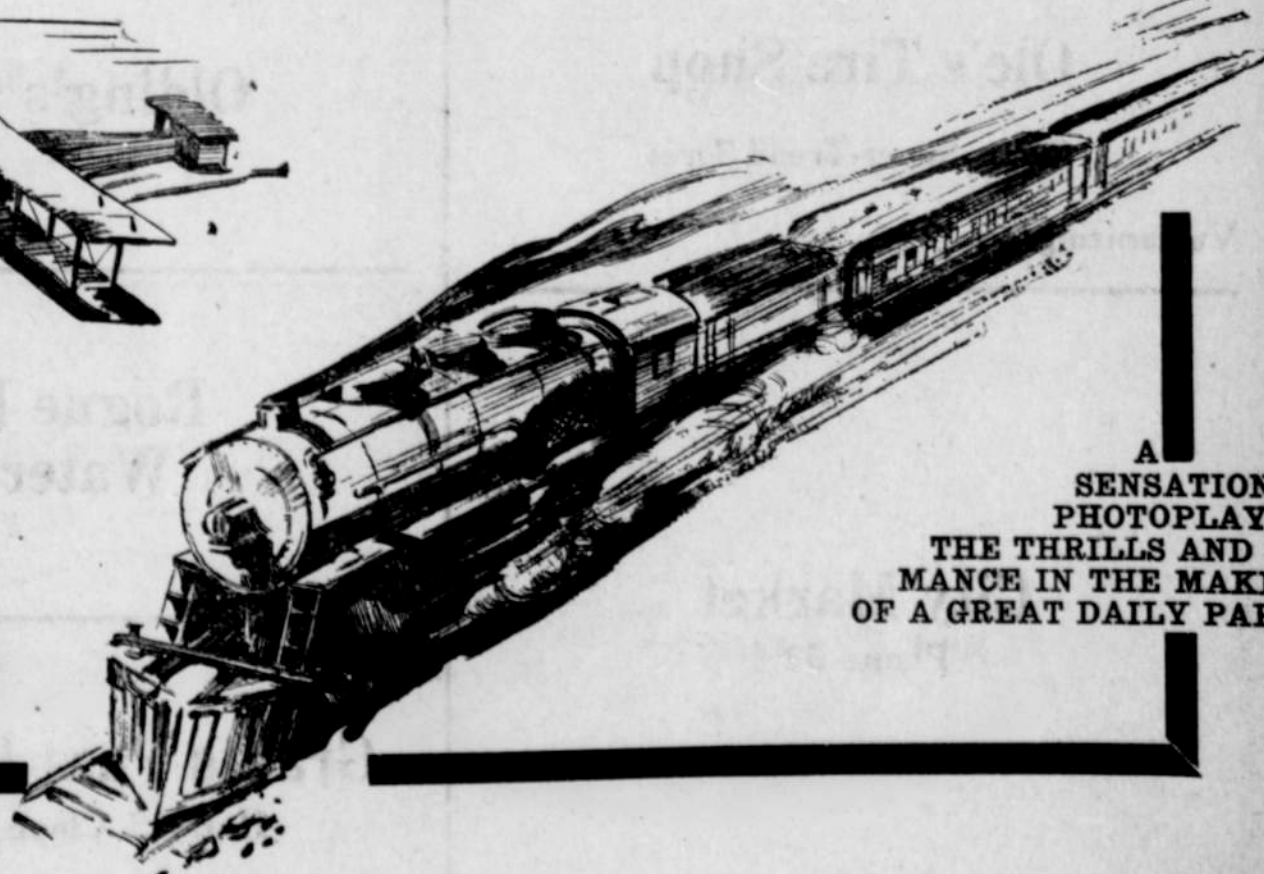
