Measurement of Water

To the Editor:

Water used for irrigation is measured in three ways:

By the statutory or miners inch.

By the second foot.

By the acre foot.

The inch represents the amount of water that will flow through an inch square hole under four inches of pressure.

The second foot represents the amount of water flowing through a gate or in a stream or ditch by a fixed point in a second of time.

An acre foot represents the depth of water put on the land during the irrigating season.

To illustrate: Where the inch measurement is used. One-half inch per acre is the amount used. One-half inch per acre allowed to flow continuously from April 1st till November 1st would cover the land to a depth of three feet and nine inches. While the usual depth required in arid districts is about 30 inches.

A second foot of water is equal to 38.39 inches, but is commonly called 40 inches. A stream or ditch flowing one cubic foot of water per second of time is sufficient to water 80 acres of land.

An acre foot represents one foot in depth of water on an acre of land. It usually requires 2½ acre feet to irrigate an acre during the season.

In a district of small farms the inch measurement is most convenient as to measure water, for a one acre garden tract by the cubic foot measurement would be quite a problem. One-half inch of water will not water a single acre of land as the evaporation takes up so much. It is necessary that several parties with small farms combine, and pool their water supply and use it in turn.

The smallest flow of water a man can use to advantage is 5 in. and he can accomplish three times as much with ten inches.

Because of evaporation and waste it is necessary that the man with one or two acres have a larger quantity of water per acre than the man with a larger tract as evaporation is greater in proportion on a small stream than a larger one.

Fortunately in Rogue River valley water is so abundant that careful measurement is not necessary.

FLIGHT OF BIRDS BEING

STUDIED BY GOVERNMENT

Department of Agriculture Issues

Bulletin, Giving Data.

Washington.—Sportsmen, ornithologists and others interested in bird migration and the protection of game birds will find information of value in a new United States Department of Agriculture Bulletin, 1145, "Migration Records from Wild Ducks and Other Birds Banded in the Salt Lake Valley, Utah," by Alexander Wetmore, assistant biologist, bureau of biological survey.

Bands were placed on 1,241 individuals of 23 species of birds, the majority on wild ducks of 9 species. Returns were received from 12 species. Of these, 185 birds were retaken out of 1,195 banded.

of green-winged teal, cinnamon teal and spoonbills seen to leave Utah to winter in California. Part of the pintails, after leaving Utah, go to California to winter in the interior valleys, while others cross to the great plains and go to the Gulf coast in Texas. The spring migration carries the latter birds northward through the plains again, and eastward as far as western Missouri and north at least into southern Canada.

Details concerning the returns on gadwalls, redheads, white-faced glossy ibises, great blue herons, snowy herons, American coots and a double-crested cormorant are included in the record in tabulated form. As an example of how some of these returns come in may be cited the case of a Mexican peon at Mexcaltitlan, Territory of Tepic, Mexico, who brought a bit of aluminum to a Japanese labor contractor, saying he had found it on the leg of a heron that he had killed and eaten. The band was returned to the biological survey, Washington, D. C.
