This Project was developed to manage the concerns regarding the deteriorating culvert now in place on Little Phillips Creek. The Walla Walla Ranger District proposes to remove the existing cul-vert, restore channel morphology, and relocate several motorized vehicle gates leading into the general area. In addition, the adjacent 0.7 miles of Forest Road 3734 would be decommissioned and restored to natural conditions and 1 mile at the upper end of Forest Road 3734 would be opened to motorized use.
