### BMS intramural teams end season

On Wednesday, the Baker Middle School intramural boys played their final game of the season. The purple team, coached by Howerton, beat the white team, coached by Dalke, 34-30.

The purple team jumped to a 9-4 lead in the first quarter and added to that, leading 19-14 at halftime.

Dominic Myers had a team high 17 points with 11 coming in the first half for the purple team. Kaden Carpenter, also on the purple team, scored all 6 of his points in the first half.

The white team got within 3 points in the third quarter, trailing 20-23 at the end of the period. The white team got its first lead in the fourth quarter as a result of some great defense but were unable to keep it. Logan Speelman led the white team with 17 points. Dysan Robb added 13 points and had several assists.

The other purple team scoring was 5 points by Daniel Humbert and 2 points each by Izek Cleveland and Brandon McCullough.

### Wilson perfect in BYU bowl win

BOISE (AP) — Zach Wilson set a BYU record and tied the NCAA bowl mark with 18-for-18 passing, throwing for 317 yards and four touchdowns in the Cougars' 49-18 victory over Western Michigan on Friday in the Famous Idaho Potato Bowl.

Selected the game MVP, Wilson tied the NCAA bowl record for completion percentage set by Riley Skinner at 11 for 11 for Wake Forest in the 2008 EagleBank Bowl.

Down 10-7 at halftime, BYU (7-6) scored 28 points in the third quarter. Wilson connected with Aleva Hifo for a 70-yard scoring strike, and Riley Burt had a 37-yard touchdown run in the quarter.

Western Michigan (7-6) rolled up 192 yards of offense in the first half, then managed only 41 yards on 18 plays in the decisive third quarter.

### Mariners trade Gamel to Brewers

SEATTLE (AP) — The Seattle Mariners acquired outfielder Domingo Santana from the Milwaukee Brewers on Friday in exchange for outfielder Ben Gamel and minor-league pitcher Noah Zavalo.

The swap of young outfielders adds a right-handed power bat to the Mariners' lineup and provides the Brewers with a versatile corner outfielder.

The 26-year-old Santana is two years removed from hitting 30 home runs and having 85 RBIs, but he struggled to find a consistent spot in the Brewers' outfield last season after the additions of Lorenzo Cain and NL MVP Christian Yelich. Santana appeared in just 85 games and hit .265 with five homers and 20 RBIs. He played even less in the field, appearing in only 55 games defensively a year after starting 138 games in right field for the Brewers.

The 26-year-old Gamel appeared in 101 games last season for the Mariners and hit .272, but started just 69 games. He was a regular defensive replacement and can play both left and right field.

# Hebard, Ionescu lead Ducks to rout

EUGENE (AP) — Another day, another blowout for No. 7 Oregon.

Ruthy Hebard scored 23 points on 11-for-12 shooting and had 15 rebounds, Sabrina Ionescu added her NCAA-record 14th triple-double and Oregon beat overmatched UC Irvine 115-69 on Friday.

"Coach always says go up strong, so I know when I'm on balance I can definitely finish strong," said Hebard, who set an NCAA record last season with 33 consecutive field goals.

The junior forward's only miss came on a short jumper early in the third quarter during which the Ducks shot 14 of 19 and easily pulled away to a 30-point lead.

"And she shouldn't have missed that one," Ionescu said with Hebard seated nearby.

A day after setting the triple-double mark, Ionescu grabbed her 10th rebound

in the fourth quarter to complete the triple-double. She also had 13 points and 14 assists.

"We did it as a team tonight," Ionescu said. "My teammates were boxing out hard and letting me get the loose (rebounds)."

Hebard had 13 points and 10 rebounds in the first half. She also made her first six shots for 19 consecutive field goals over her last three games.

Oregon (11-1), the nation's top scoring team, matched its season high for points while shooting 48 of 74 for 64.9 percent. Satou Sabally led the Ducks with 27 points, Erin Boley added 17 and Maite Cazorla had 13.

The Ducks outscored the

Anteaters 64-29 in the second half, similar to what they did in their 46-point victory over Air Force on Thursday.

"It looked like in both games in the second half the ladies decided to wake up and really get going," said Mark Campbell, the acting coach filling in again for suspended Oregon coach Kelly Graves. "When you have the leadership of these upperclassmen, it helps a lot. They know how to turn it on, and they put their foot on the gas pedal in the second half."

Jordan Sanders led UC Irvine (9-2) with 15 points, and Andee Ritter and Lauren Saiki each had 11.

The Ducks dominated inside and out with a 60-20 edge in points in the paint,

a 53-28 rebounding margin and 34 assists on their 48 field goals. Lydia Giomi had 11 rebounds off the bench and Cazorla added 10 assists.

Oregon made its first seven shots and 12 of 15 in the first quarter but couldn't shake the Anteaters, who trailed 28-26 behind Sanders' 11 points. Ritter's third 3-pointer tied it at 32-32 early in the second, but the Ducks closed the half on a 13-4 run to lead 51-40.

Oregon goes into a two-week holiday break with its nine-player rotation established and healthy. The Ducks have only an exhibition game against Division II Concordia before they open defense of their Pac-12 championship.
