CLASSIFIEDS WORK! How To Get Results

1. Unique selling points. To determine the uniqueness of a product or service, think like the people who you want to respond to your ad.
2. Complete words. Limit abbreviations. they can confuse the reader or obstruct communication. If you decide to use some abbreviations, avoid unusual ones.
3. Mind Images. Appeal to the readers senses, such as sight, touch or emotions.
4. Always include the price. If you are flexible, include best offer or negotiable.
5. If brand names are involved, always use them. Brand names convey a sense of quality, dependability and appropriateness.
6. Give your ad a chance to work. The potential customer pool for your product, merchandise, or service is not static. Different readers and potential customers read the newspaper each day. It is important for you to "throw out an advertising net" to catch as many customers as possible. Remember, higher priced items normally need more days exposure to sell.
7. Be sure to include a phone number where you can be reached.
