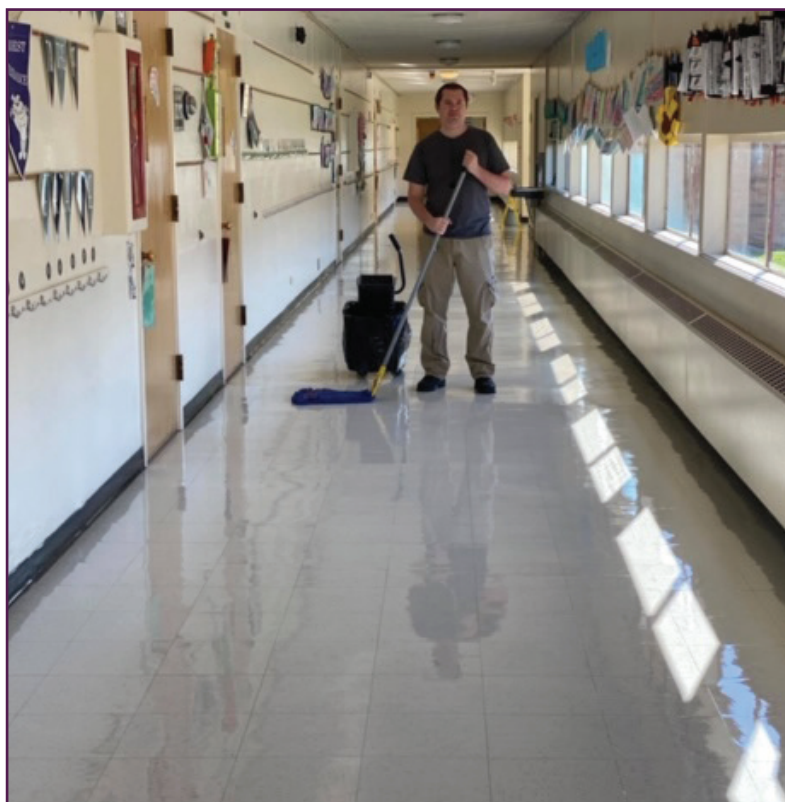


Brooklyn's halls are sparkling
