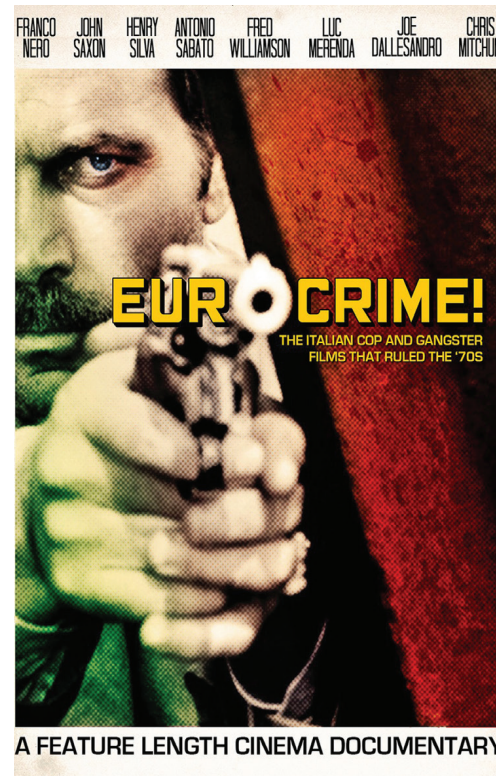
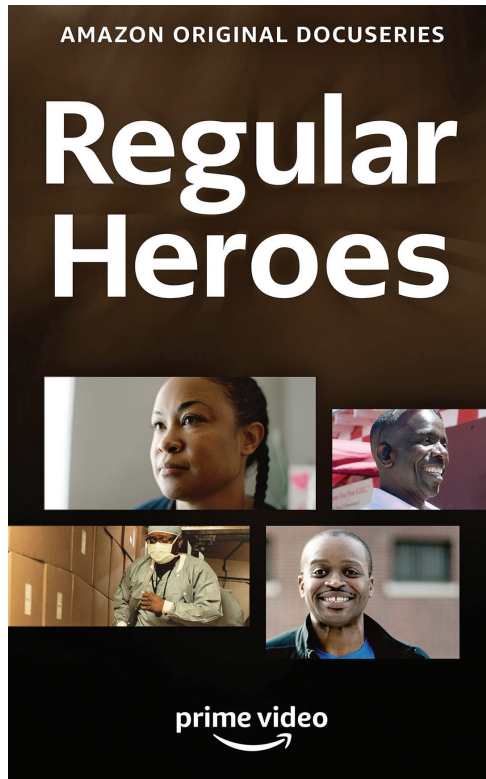

Director Rian Johnson’s (“Looper,” “The Brothers Bloom”) hugely entertaining 2019 comedy caper stars a game cast including Daniel Craig, Jamie Lee Curtis, Toni Collette, Chris Evans and Christopher Plummer in this tale of a detective investigating the death of the patriarch of a family of eccentrics.
