8 ounces (about 2 1/2 cups) mezzi rigatoni or fusilli pasta

2 tablespoons olive oil 1 tablespoon butter

or bacon fat 1/2 large sweet onion, very thinly sliced 1/3 cup flour

2 cups nonfat milk 1/2 cup half-and-half or heavy (whipping) cream

1/2 teaspoon salt 1 teaspoon hot red pepper sauce, plus more for serving

1 cup (3 ounces) shredded white cheddar cheese 1 cup (3 ounces) shredded

Gruyere or Swiss cheese 1 1/2 cups (4 to 5 ounces) small dice corned beef

(or smoky ham) Chopped parsley and green onions, for garnish

1. Have all ingredients ready and set near the cooking surface.

2. Heat a large pot of salted water to boil over high heat. Add 8 ounces pasta. Cook, stirring often, until al dente (nearly tender but not soft when tasted), 8 to 10 minutes. Scoop out 1 cup of the cooking liquid and reserve it. Drain the pasta well and let stand while you make the sauce.

3. While the pasta cooks, heat 2 tablespoons olive oil and 1 tablespoon butter or bacon fat in medium-size saucepan over medium heat. Add 1/2 large sweet onion,

thinly sliced; cook and stir until onion is golden brown, 5 to 8 minutes.

4. Sprinkle 1/3 cup flour over onions; cook and stir for 1 minute. Whisk in 2 cups nonfat milk and 1/2 cup halfand-half (or whipping cream) and 1/2 teaspoon salt. Cook, whisking constantly until milk thickens, about 3 minutes. Remove from heat and season with 1 teaspoon red pepper

hot sauce. 5. When pasta is done, stir both cheeses into the hot white sauce. Add drained pasta and corned beef; mix gently. Taste for salt. Gently


