



The City of Haines is eligible to apply for a 2021 Community Development Block Grant from Business Oregon. Community Development Block Grant funds come from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development. The grants can be used for public facilities and housing improvements, primarily for persons with low and moderate incomes.

Approximately \$26 million of CDBG-CV (CARES ACT Funded) will be awarded to Oregon non-metropolitan cities and counties in 2021. The maximum grant that a city or county can receive is \$750,000. The City of Haines is preparing an application for a 2021 Community Development Block Grant from Business Oregon for construction of water distribution system improvements to replace or rehabilitate aging and out of useful life water distribution elements prone to leaking. It is estimated that the proposed project will benefit at least 415 persons, of whom 56.4% will be low or moderate income.

Approximately \$12 million will be awarded to Oregon non-metropolitan cities and counties in 2021. The maximum grant that a city or county can receive is \$2,500,000. The City of Haines is preparing an application for a 2021 Community Development Block Grant from Business Oregon to replace or rehabilitate aging and out of useful life water distribution elements prone to leaking and potentially construct a new well. It is estimated that the proposed project will benefit at least 415 persons, of whom 56.4% will be low or moderate income.
