I really like my podcasts. From podcasts based on Marvel graphic novels to podcasts about sports uniforms and logos, my phone is full of a wide variety of them. But one that I find myself making sure I don't miss on a daily basis is a podcast called TEDx Shorts. The podcast is an offshoot of the familiar TED Talks series of videos from expert speakers on education, business, science tech and creativity. Each episode of the podcast — there's a new one every day — is generally no more than 10 minutes in length and tackles a variety of topics. Some of the more recent episodes have centered on climate change, what's your time really worth,

and is streaming killing music. Another, titled "The secret soundtrack of the sea," offered a look at the intricate sounds that exist in the ocean and why listening to the soundtrack can help us protect it. I wound up listening to that episode a few times. The TEDx Shorts podcast is hosted by Atossa Leoni and is a great way to get a daily dose of material that provokes thought and, at least for me, leaves me wanting to learn more. The short-form podcast is available on all podcast platforms — Stitcher, Apple, Spotify, iHeartRadio.
