weekly classes**

JOSEPH — The Joseph Center for Arts and Culture, 403 N. Main St., offers a schedule of art classes every week. Walk-in Wednesday sessions are from 10 a.m. to noon. Pamela Beach offers in-person instruction in a variety of mediums every Wednesday for all skill levels. Cost is \$20; pre-register or pay when you go. The July 21 and Aug. 4 classes are special opportunities to learn a printmaking project.

Wine Glass Painting is held Wednesdays from 5-7 p.m. Paint wine glasses to be given to those who purchase opening night tickets for the Wallowa Valley Festival of the Arts. No experience is necessary. It's free and walk-ins are welcome.

The Nez Perce Story happens Thursdays from 1-2 p.m. Rich Wandschneider leads an ongoing in-person informal discussion about the Indians who once lived in the Wallowa Valley: who they were; how and why they left; and where they are now.

For kids, summertime Thursday classes for ages 5-8 are held from 10-11:15 a.m. with Mary Ambrosion, and ages 9-12 from 1-2:30 p.m. with Pamela Beach. Cost is \$10. Pre-registration is strongly recommended as classes fill quickly and are limited to 10 students. The schedule is: beading on July 15, Paint a Bird for July 29, Printmaking Postcards on Aug. 12, and kites for Aug. 19.

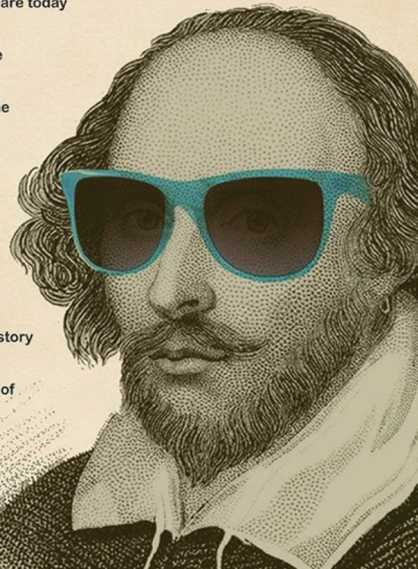
