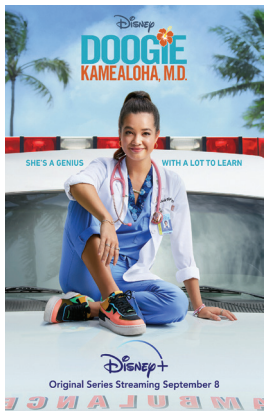
"Dug Days" (Available now)

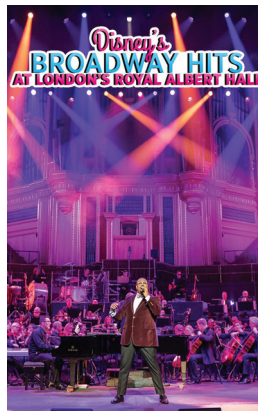
"Doogie Kamealoha, M.D." (Available now)
