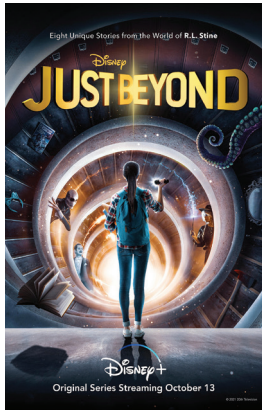


What's Available NOW On

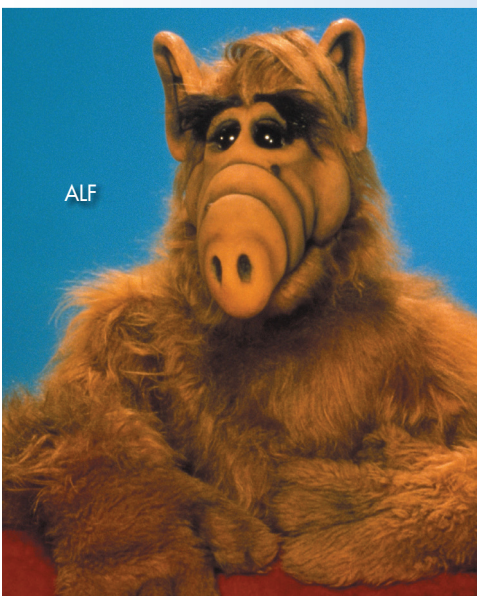
