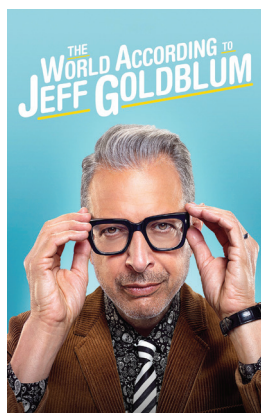
"Home Sweet Home Alone" (Nov. 12)
