Taste buds change over time, however, which gets to the topic of a creamy holiday soup made from golden chanterelle mushrooms.

Preparing mushroom soup requires some attention to detail. One recipe calls for a quart and a half of chicken broth, two tablespoons of melted butter, three cloves of minced garlic, and a cup of sliced shallots for

every pound of cleaned and trimmed chanterelles. Add flour to thicken, a splash of white wine if it makes your heart sing, and let the mixture simmer for 30 minutes.

Every fall I drift red hackle flies for mountain whitefish when they school up near fall chinook salmon redds to gobble up loose eggs.

females or "hens" burst with large roe sacs that need not go to waste.

To make golden caviar, carefully remove the bright orangish roe from the fish body cavity and cut into 2-inch or so chunks. Individual eggs are small, on the order of 1/8-inch in diameter.

The eggs are glossy, jewel-like orange, almost too

pretty to eat. Serve with a selection of gourmet crackers and crème fraiche. I like to think of this appetizer as a blessing from Mother Whitefish.

While it's possible these culinary treats won't displace sweet potato-and-marshmallow delight on what we kids used to call "the grown-up table," odds are good their presence on the hors d'oeuvre tray will cajole taste buds.
