**EAGLE CAP EXTREME RETURNS TO JOSEPH THIS WEEKEND**

ENTERPRISE — After a year hiatus, the Eagle Cap Extreme Sled Dog Races return to the Wallowa Mountains. The race starts at noon Thursday, Jan. 20.

The second leg of the 31-mile and 22-mile junior races are scheduled for noon, Friday, Jan. 21, but race officials suggest checking in with Race Central as the start times of the second stages may be adjusted.

The 100-mile racers are estimated to finish Friday morning at Ferguson Ridge while the 31-mile and 22-mile race stage finishes can be viewed late Thursday and Friday afternoons. The 200-mile racers will finish

their course at Ferguson Ridge Saturday, between early morning and afternoon.

**HURRICANE CREEK GRANGE SPONSORS CHILI COOK-OFF JAN. 20**

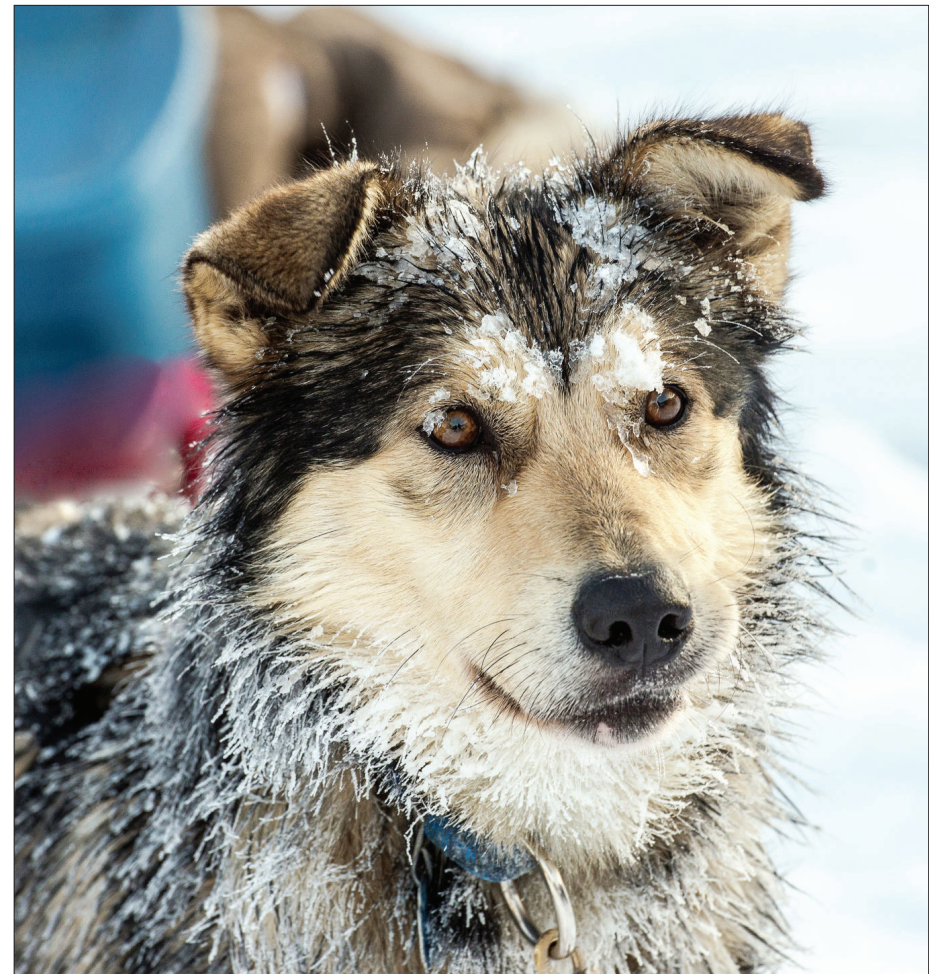
