


"Movie: The Protégé"

Martin Campbell ("The Mask of Zorro," "Vertical Limit") directed this 2021 thriller about Anna (Maggie Q, "Pivoting"), a skilled contract killer who vows to get revenge for the brutal murder of the assassin who taught her everything she knows.
