The Wallowa County Board of Commissioners adopted an ordinance to refer to the voters that permanently prohibits psilocybin-related businesses in Wallowa County.

A "Yes" vote would permanently prohibit the establishment of psilocybin product manufacturers and psilocybin service centers within the unincorporated areas of Wallowa County.


