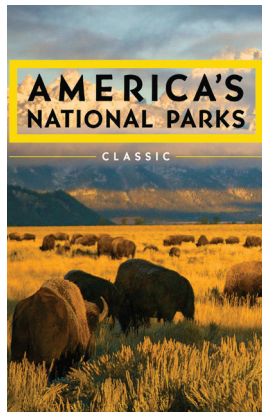


What's Available NOW On

America’s system of national parks is a destination magnet for millions of viewers annually, but this series — which was three years in the making — reveals what happens in those parks away from the freely accessible scenic lookout points. The opening episode is devoted to the Olympic Peninsula on the west coast, home to one of North America’s most diverse parks.

Oscar-nominated actress Naomi Watts narrates this addition to the hit “Secrets of the Zoo” reality series franchise, which was filmed at the celebrated Taronga Zoo Sydney, home to more than 5,000 animals under the care of 240 keepers on the staff. The program provides rare behind-the-scenes access to the facility.

This third installment of the “Magic Quest” competition features “Zombies 3” stars Meg Donnelly, Pearce Joza, Kylee Russell and Matt Cornett embarking on a challenge-filled quest through EPCOT at Walt Disney World as part of the Florida park’s 50th anniversary celebration.
