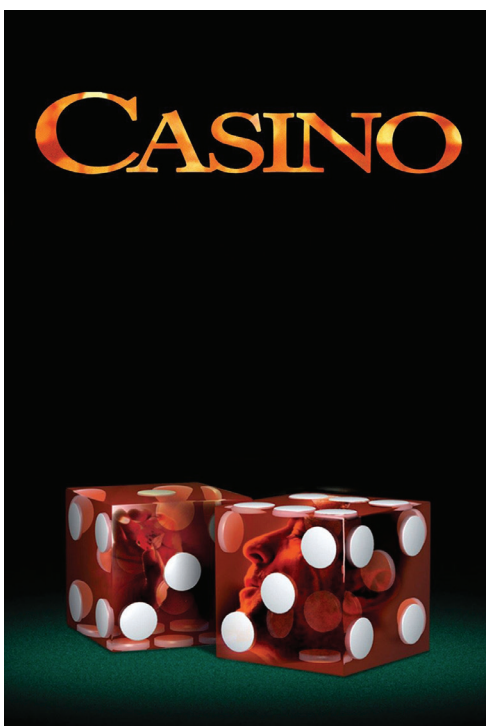
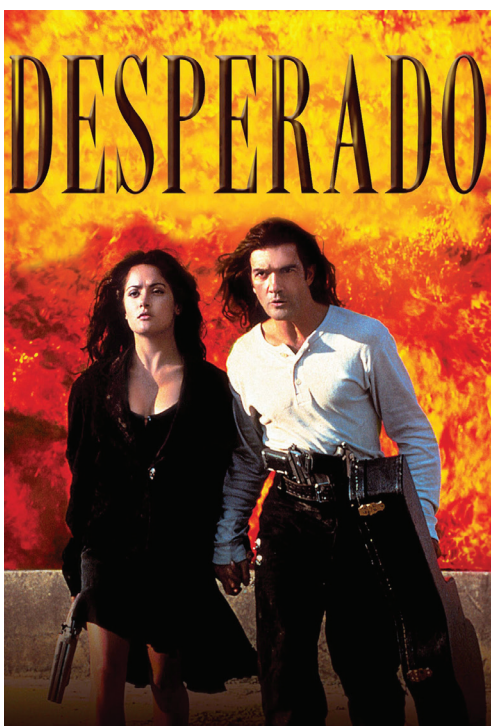

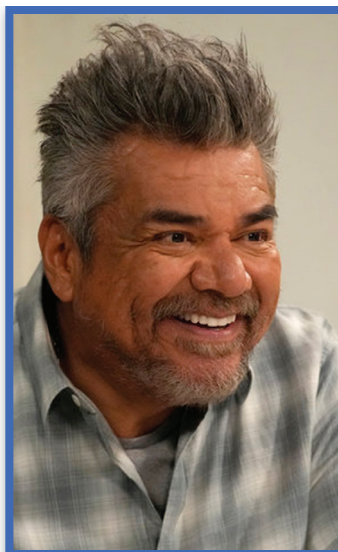
“Movie: The Way, Way Back”
