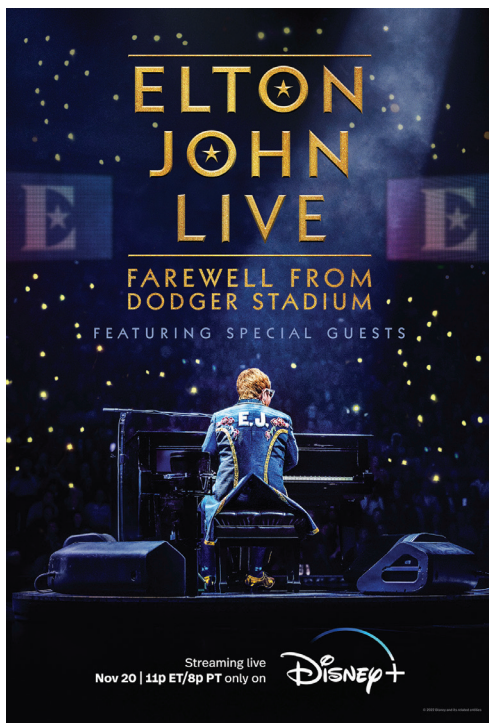


# What's Available NOW On
