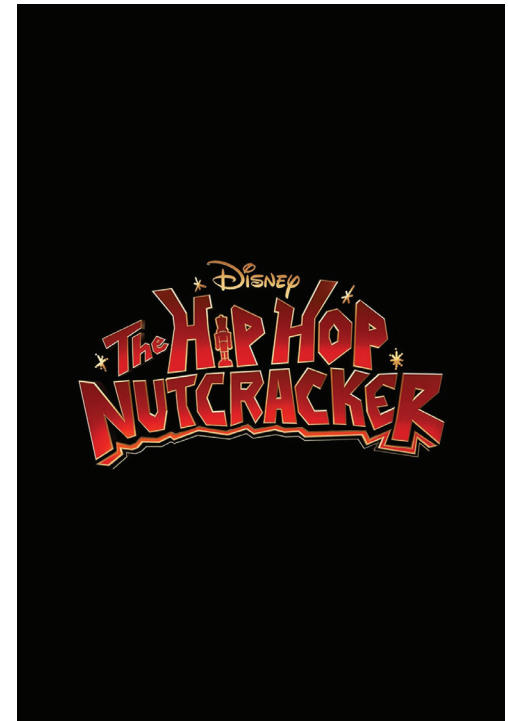
## “The Guardians of the Galaxy Holiday Special” (Available now)

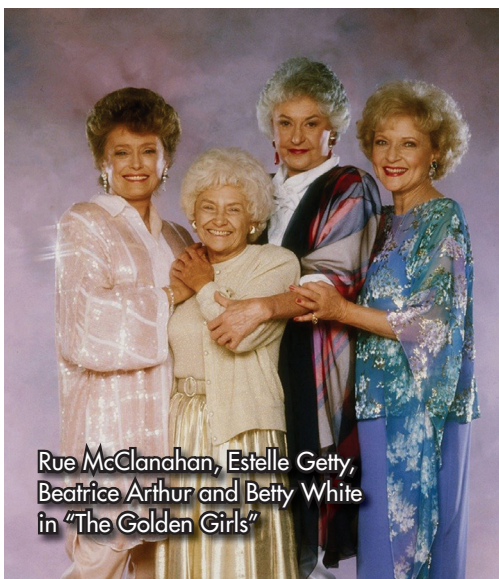
## “Mickey Saves Christmas” (Available now)
