**TIPS FOR FEEDING CALVES**

General instruction furnished by the U. S. Bureau of Animal Industry—read the following carefully.

1. Provides a variety of feeds at all times, if possible. It is easier to supply the proper amounts of the desired nutrients which the calf needs if several different feeds are used. The ration will also be more palatable.

2. Do not make sudden changes in the feeds used or in the amounts if it becomes necessary to change feeds from any, closer to alfalfa hay.
