Picric Acid Available

A great impetus will be given the clearing of logged-off and burned-off lands of the state through the use of a large amount of picric acid which the Government has made available for the land-owners, according to a statement issued by Charles Hall, of Klamath Falls, president of the Oregon State Chamber of Commerce, following the recent notification from Washington that Oregon has been allotted 195,000 pounds of this explosive.

According to Government bulletins, picric acid is of greater strength than dynamite and is safer to handle. It is an explosive which was used in the great war, and with a great surplus on hand at the conclusion of the war, the Government decided to turn it over to the different states on a basis of the amount of logged-off land in each state.

Land owners of the state must place their orders for the picric acid with the Oregon Agricultural College, according to advice from Washington. When the number of orders equals a carload, the Agricultural College will forward this order to the U. S. Department of Agriculture and the explosive will be shipped to the state from the nearest cartridge plant. Individual orders will be limited to 1,000 pounds, and the total cost of the explosive, including the cost of cartridge, handling, distributing and freight, will be in the neighborhood of 12 cents per pound.
