Because the ocean is fluid while the solid crust of the earth resists deformation by the gravitational forces of the sun and moon, tides are produced. Dr. Miller, of the Royal Astronomical Society of Canada, has stated that the fact the earth does not yield to tidal forces proves that the interior of the earth cannot be liquid, since the thickest crust would be deformed by tidal movements.
