### NOTICE TO BIDDERS

#### Sewer Construction

Notice is hereby given that the Common Council will receive sealed proposals or bids for the construction of a sewer:

On First street from a point 100 feet east of the east line of Maple street thence west following First street to a northerly extension of the east line of block 18 in Elliott's Addition; thence southwesterly following the present gulch to a connection with the old wooden sewer in Hall street;

On Maple street from a point 100 feet north of the north line of First Street to a connection with the proposed sewer in First street.

Bids may be submitted for either the whole work necessary to complete the proposed improvement, or for such subdivisions thereof as will not materially conflict with the completion of the remaining portion. Forms of bids and contract and bond may be had upon application to the City Recorder.

The Common Council reserves the right to reject any or all bids with or without cause.

Certified check in the sum of five per cent of the amount of bid must be submitted with bid, to be forfeited to the City of Coquille in the event that the bidder refuses to sign the contract and execute bond as provided in said Ordinance, said bond to be in the sum of fifty per cent of the total amount of the contract.

The work to be completed within sixty days from the date of awarding the contract, time being of the essence thereof.

Bids must be filed on or before the hour of eight o'clock P. M. on the 16th day of June, A. D., 1924.

All bids must be made for a lump sum, accompanied by unit prices for the purpose of estimating additions or deductions made during the course of the work.
