O. 1926, there was filed in the office of the City Recorder by said Recorder and Committee on Streets of the Common Council of the City of Coquille a proposed assessment of the cost and expense of the improvement of Knowlton Avenue from a point 64.5 feet west of the west line of Coquille Heights to the northeast line of Grand View Terrace, and Avenue B from the northeast line of Grand View Terrace to a point 60 degrees, 9 minutes east 170 feet therefrom, within the corporate limits of the City of Coquille and said proposed assessment is open to the inspection of all persons interested.

The whole cost of said improvement is the sum of \$1188.67, and the boundaries of the district proposed to be assessed are as follows:
