

Notice of City Budget

Certified check in the sum of five per cent of the amount of bid must be submitted with bid, to be forfeited if the bidder refuses to sign the contract and execute bond as provided in said Ordinance, said bond to be in the sum of fifty per cent of the total amount of the contract.

The work to be completed within sixty days from the date of awarding the contract, time being of the essence thereof.

Bids must be filed on or before the hour of 7:30 o'clock P. M. on the 7th day of November, A. D. 1927.

All bids must be made for a lump sum, accompanied by unit prices for the purpose of estimating additions or reductions made during the course of the work.
