Despite the drizzle and wet grounds last Sunday, the game between Cottage Grove and the Coquille Loggers was the cleanest and shortest game played so far this season. Only three errors, and all at first base, were charged up and the game was over in an hour and thirty-six minutes.

The statement that Coquille fans are strong for the Loggers was proven, too, for the grandstand was well filled and cars lined both sides of the diamond.

Heath started things, after getting a walk, by going to third on an infield out, third to first, by Foss, and scored on Marlow's single.

In the second, Brown was hit, Roper sacrificed him to second, and then the barrage was laid down. Singles in succession by Pillsbury, Heath, Foss, Marlow, fielder's choice by play on Fortier's infield tap, and a home run by Rice, this time over the hill into deep right, scored six runs. Stewart followed with a three bagger but died there when Brown struck out.

Eddie Foss, playing his last game for Coquille, batted 1.000 with four hits in four times at bat. Marlow got four in five, two of them triples, and "Chico" hit safely three out of five.

Jack Pillsbury pitched a splendid game, walked no one, struck out five, and was hit safely but once.

His no-hit opportunity having been spoiled by Spiess' single in the fourth, "Penny" Sturdivant was sent to the rubber in the seventh, to the accompaniment of prolonged tooting from automobile horns. Cole's triple and Hogan's single in that inning saved the visitors from a shut-out, but in the eighth and ninth "Penny" held them hitless.

Marshfield performed the unexpected by defeating Eugene, at the university city fair grounds, 4-1, and Bandon dropped a 7-2 game at Myrtle Point.
