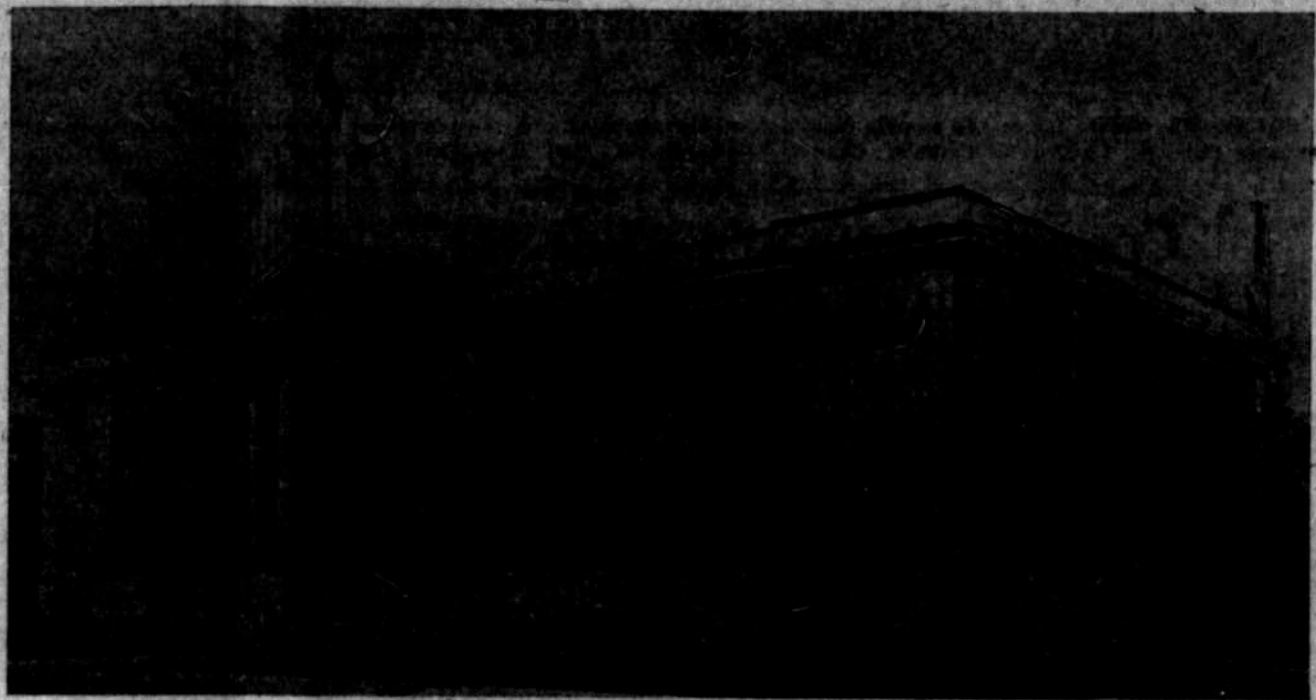

It would not be possible to secure such a building and site now for anything near the total cost of \$14,302.34. It is of brick, and 502.24. The ground on which it stands beside the city offices accommodates the Coos County Health Department.
