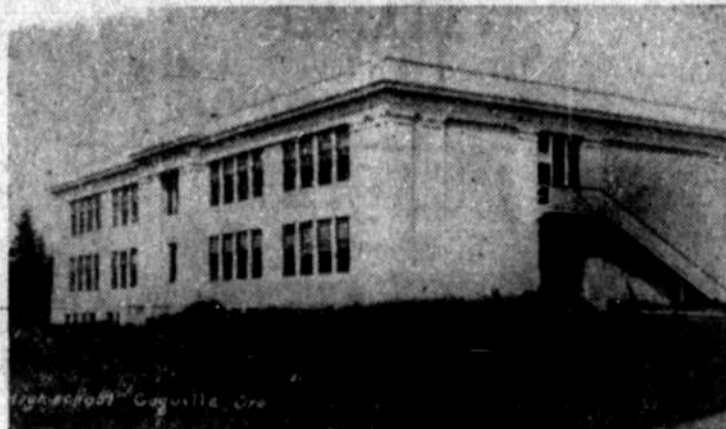
business for the last seven years. His favorite sport is horseback riding, having spent many hours in a saddle.

The faculty of the Coquille Schools numbers 31 men and women who teach 728 students, 503 of whom attend the elementary schools and 225 the high school. Your three fine school buildings were erected at a cost of \$125,588.20. The tax on your property for school purposes is 24.7 mills. The amount of the school budget for Coquille totals \$71,475.59. The monthly payroll of the teachers amounts to \$4,446.12.
