- 2.—All workers will be authorized representatives of this newspaper, privileged to collect paid in advance subscriptions, for which they will be paid according to regulations set forth in this announcement. All workers gathering subscriptions must report same promptly, and all must make a cash report each week or lose right to qualify for a guaranteed earning. However, all workers receive weekly pay at the time of reporting.
