The local W. C. T. U. met with Mrs. Georgia Richmond last Friday with Mrs. Ella Nelson in charge of the devotional service.

The treasurer reported 32 members had paid dues to date and that \$28 had been sent the state treasurer, Mrs. Alice Thomas, for the budget. Plans were discussed for paying the remaining \$26. When all unions in the county have paid their fourth in full, the state refunds one-fourth of the total for use in the county.

Children's Farm Home boxes to the value of \$73 have been sent and a Christmas box of new toys and articles which were made by the Daily Vacation Bible school children, consisting of dolls and dresser scarfs, are being packed for shipment. Mrs. Belle Knife is chairman.

Mrs. Georgia Richmond conducted an interesting round table on "Peace," using scripture, poems, resolutions and articles from the daily press.

A definite peace program is to be presented to congress at its next session. At least that is the plan of the National Council for the Prevention of War, which invited representatives of agriculture, labor, churches, woman's groups and educational institutions to meet in the national capital early in October to formulate basic recommendations for anti-war legislation.

Six main topics were made the planks of the so-called peace platform of the Council:

- 1. A national defense policy based on defense of American soil from invasion, and not on interests abroad;
2. Easing of international tensions through reciprocal trade agreements and stabilization of currencies;
3. Stronger neutrality legislation, including the authorization for embargoes on basic war materials;
4. International co-operation in settlement of disputes by peaceful means in accordance with the principles of the Kellogg Pact;
5. Nationalization of the munitions industry and enactment of levies to tax the profits out of war;
6. Watchful maintenance of the constitutional guarantee of freedom of speech, press and assembly.

At this Christmas season it is well to renew our efforts and give our aid to P. T. A., child training groups, educators and all those who are in an educational campaign to do away with toy firearms or the use of real firearms in play of children. Many fine toys can be had which do not promote war and keep the child's mind on war.

The hostess, assisted by Mrs. Maude Bean and Mrs. Zoe Fugelson, served refreshments suggestive of the Christmas season.

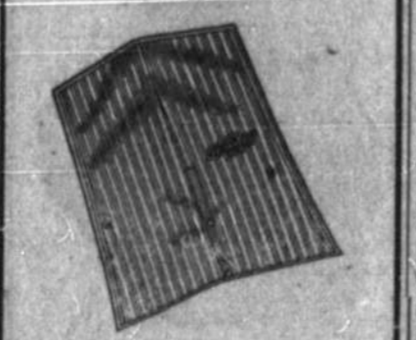
