at this time. Then it goes back to the steam box for another hour's aging.

The next stop is at the divider, where the loaf size desired is weighed out, and it is then placed in the rounder where a rapid-speed machine whirls it for a short time. Then it spends 20 minutes in the overhead proofer for further aging.

From there it passes on an endless belt into the molder which shapes the loaf into a round oblong piece of dough, a foot long. At that point two pieces of the dough are twisted together and then put on the pans for baking. Before baking, however, the loaves are again put in the steam box to rise for an hour. When it reaches the proper size it is placed in the new oven.

This is the Middleby revolving

oven, with a capacity of 296 large loaves. It is 15x16x11 feet in size, is gas heated, and the eight steel trays on which the bread pans are placed are attached to a racket which keeps the steel trays passing in a circle so that each loaf gets the same amount of heat. The heat is automatically controlled and the clock for timing indicates when the needed 38 minutes have elapsed. The temperature of the oven is 450 degrees.

When the bell rings, the bread is removed and cooled until it reaches 85 degrees when the loaf is placed in the wrapping machine and comes out perfectly covered with the Ideal Bakery's well known label.

All the equipment, even to the pans, is new and the Ideal Bakery has a plant of which its owners may well be proud.

The pastries are baked in the early morning and the bakery produces a number of specialty breads for its own retail trade.
