Advancement in Woodworking

The woodworking course in the high school was inaugurated to take the place of the Smith-Hughes course...

The instructor is George Fuller, who is a native Oregonian and received his bachelor's degree in industrial art from Oregon State College in 1936.

A good quarter of the basement space has been allotted to the teaching of woodworking. There are ten work benches, each accommodating two students.

The power tools consist of a hand-saw, table-saw, jointer, power grinder, small jig-saw, and lathe.

The boys' first project is the making of a small broom-holder. Next he may make either a stool or table, and thereafter he is allowed to select other projects of increasing difficulty.

Gluing, wood-turning and advanced work in the operation of power tools are taught the second-year class.

Adjoining the workshop is the classroom where mechanical drawing is taught. Accommodations for twenty-one students are arranged here.
